## Rules

All entrants for any Open Competitions MUST report in to the Steward between 0930 - 1000.

Amateur	Offered to any piper who does not compete in open competition; all tunes of own choice.
Open	3 tunes to be submitted in all events except Hornpipe and Jig which is own choice. Pipers will be required to play two of each tune in the light music, apart from Hornpipe and Jig, which will be one of each. The Judges will select one tune and then the competitor will choose the other, both to be played segue and in any order according to the preference of the competitor.
Hornpipe & Jig	May be held at the end of each day, time permitting, and at Judge's discretion.
Entry Fee	Open Piobaireachd, March and Strathspey & Reel: Entry Fee £3 (no matter how many classes you enter, entry fee is still £3 total). Amateur Piobaireachd, March and Strathspey & Reel: Entry Fee £2 (no matter how many classes you enter, entry fee is still £2 total). Hornpipe & Jig: Entries on the day at £3 each. We would appreciate it greatly if all entries were received here by August 1 <sup>st</sup> .

Amateur Competitions: Please report to Steward by 1200, ready to commence at approximately 1400. Amateurs may also enter higher grade competitions on the day at Judge/Steward's discretion.

Further Information: As you will see from the enclosed leaflet the Solo Piping Competitions are one of many events & competitions at the Fair which also include a Pipe Band Contest and Highland Dancing Competitions.

You may camp in the Park, but please indicate on the form if you wish to, and we will contact you with details. If you are entering late please obtain a special car pass and lapel badge from the Show Secretary on the Friday or Saturday of the event. Because of security, we must know who is camping in the park, and all we ask is that you please let us know by indicating on the entry form.

I hope competitors will enjoy the two days as much as we always do.
